Dear Parent/Carer

As you are aware Peter Weir MLA, Minister for Education in Northern Ireland announced all schools, including pre-schools, were to close on Friday 20th March 2020 until further notice.

An additional announcement followed highlighting the need to support vulnerable children, the term vulnerable encompasses those children who are in need of protection, or in need, as defined by the Children (NI) Order 1995 and children of identified key workers. Peter Weir MLA has emphasised "only sending your child to school if there are NO other viable arrangements".

A list of key workers

- **Health and Social Care**. This includes doctors, nurses, midwives, paramedics, social workers, home carers and staff required to maintain our health and social care sector
- •Education and childcare. This includes nursery and teaching staff, social workers and those specialist education professionals who will remain active during the Covid-19 response
- Public safety and national security. This includes civilians and officers in the police (including key contractors), Fire and Rescue Service, prison service and other national security roles
- **Transport**. This will include those keeping air, water, road and rail transport modes operating during the Covid-19 response
- **Utilities and Communication**. This includes staff needed for oil, gas, electricity and water (including sewage) and primary industry supplies, to continue during the Covid-19 response, as well as key staff in telecommunications, post and delivery, services and waste disposal
- Food and other necessary goods. This includes those involved in food production, processing, distribution and sale, as well as those essential to the provision of other key goods (e.g. hygiene, medical etc.)
- Other workers essential to delivering key public services

 Key national and local government including those administrative occupations essential to the effective delivery of the Covid-19 response

The most recent scientific advice on how to further limit the spread of COVID-19 is clear. If children can stay safely at home, they should, to limit the chance of the virus spreading.

(Department of Education General guidance on COVID-19)

The aim is to keep the number of pupils coming into pre-school low to ensure the safety of children and staff.

If you fall into one of these categories and as a <u>last resort</u> require this provision please contact Mrs Dempsey on 07557305699 by text detailing your job description and your intention to send your child.

Due to cleaning of premises and resources on Monday 23rd March 2020 provision will start on Tuesday 24th March 2020.

You will receive confirmation before your child can attend on Tuesday 24th March 2020. Contact and confirmation must be made prior to your child attending.

Session time will be as normal 9.10 - 12.00 starting Tuesday 24th March 2020.
